- Three mini surveys issued to engage membership and guide Task Force work
- 1,782 total responses from all surveys
- Common theme identified in surveys was for APA to look within the organization to address Structural Racism
- Three primary Task Force Workgroups focused on APA Assembly, Components, and BOT
